On the Gameday

- Work with the Marketing team, General Manager, and Broadcast Director on a PA script for the games
- Prepare stats, stories, and other information for live radio and TV broadcasts
- Work with the marketing team on writing promotions for scripts, live broadcasts, and on-field promotions
- Update coach and player bios with stats and other baseball related events

After Gameday

- Write post game stories to post on the website and social media, and to send to local news stations
- Assist content creation team with website edits and updates
- Create a stat book template for the season to give to fans
