DO OR DIE TAKE 2: St. Cloud clashes with Eau Claire in the North Division Championship game (second half winner vs first half winner). It is the second trip ('15, '16) to the postseason for the Rox franchise, which only dates back to 2012. The River Bats franchise in St. Cloud won 3 NWL titles in 1998, 2000, & 2007. The Rox have reached one NWL title series in '15 (3-2 in playoff games total). Eau Claire has been a franchise since 2005 and they have made it to two NWL Title series ('07 lost to the River Bats). This is the first time the Express have made the playoffs since 2010 (won NWL title over Rochester). Winner of today's game moves on to the NWL Championship series to face either Wisconsin Rapids or Battle Creek.

TOUCH 'EM ALL: Webb Bobo hit the decisive 2-run HR in round 1 of the playoffs Monday. It was all the offense the team could muster on Monday (0 hits from 3 inning onward). He became the 3rd Rox player to hit a HR in the playoffs (Lee Miller & John Sansone in 2015). It was his first HR since July 5. Bobo hit a rough patch prior to this as in his final 10 regular season games went just 5-26 at the plate. He played in 38 regular season games and only had 4 multi-hit games.

LEAD THE WAY: The arms on the hill seem to be the driving force for the Rox in their postseason play. In round 1 yesterday, three Rox hurlers recorded a total of 14 strikeouts (1 shy of season high). Logan Salow documented 9 strikeouts in 6 innings and now has 79 K's (Rox single season record--including playoffs). Salow passed Reese Gregory who had 76 K's in 2014. Like Salow, Gregory put together a tremendous playoff performance in first round last season (9 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 10 K).

#ROXSOLIDWALL: The Rox bullpen has been dynamite recently. In the last 5 games (including Monday), the group has logged 15.2 innings, recorded 21 strikeouts, & has only absorbed 5 earned runs. The bullpen has 30 saves this season (most in NWL).

SOME CHILLY BATS: The Rox were out-hit 28-10 in their last two games of the regular season. The squad hit .245 in August during the regular season (3rd lowest total in NWL & the lowest batting average out of any playoff team). Marcus Carson and Denis Karas were the two spark plugs late in the season. Carson had 8 hits in his last 7 games of the regular season and scored 7 runs in the last 5 affairs. In the last 4 games (not including playoffs), Karas went 6-14 with 4 runs, & 2 HR.

AT THE BUZZER!!! St. Cloud has played in a ton of close games over the last 2 and a half weeks. In 18 of the last 22 affairs, the team has experienced contests decided by 3 runs or less (13-5 record). This includes 12 one run games. In total the Rox have participated in 22 one run games this season and have compiled a 14-8 record in this circumstance.

EAU CLAIRE STARTER: LHP Brody Rodning, 6-1, 170 (3-1, 3.91)

Rodning will make his 10th start of the season for the Express. This will be his 3rd start against the Rox. His first against St. Cloud came on June 26 (6 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 5 BB, 7 K--this was the game that ended the Rox 10 game winning streak). Rodning battled the Rox again on July 22 (6 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 2 K)---this was his last start on the mound with the exception of the prospect game on 8/9. Brody attends Minnesota St-Mankato (D II) and just finished his sophomore season. He threw 74.2 innings (most on team) in 12 starts, 13 app...(84 K, 36 BB, 4.34 ERA). In 2015, Brody was a part of the team that went to the D II CWS and finished 3rd in the nation. Longest outing 8.1 IP on May 6. Brody grew up in Gaylord, MN about 50 miles southwest of Minneapolis.
