#ROXREVIEW: The Rox bounced back Friday night with their 4th shutout win of the season in a 3-0 decision over the Loggers. Dom Austing got his second win of the season, while Kyle Boser and Brent Killam finished off the last 4 innings. All of the runs and half of St. Cloud's hits came in the 2nd inning. It started with a Cameron Eden leadoff double. Then after a Michael Busch walk, Eric Feliz drove in Eden for the first run. Then Spencr Holcomb singled to bring in Busch, and then following an error Feliz scored on that same play. Besides that STC did not have any big innings. It didn't matter though as the Rox pitching was strong again and got their first shutout since last Thursday.

#ROXSOLIDPITCHING: Despite the tough outing Thursday, the Rox still hold the lowest ERA in the Northwoods League at 2.44. The staff has continued to dominant opposing hitters, giving up just a .207 batting average (2nd) and the 2nd lowest WHIP (1.2). St. Cloud now also owns the most shutouts in the league with 4. Between the other 9 teams in the North Division they only have 2 combined shutouts thus far.

JUST STOPPING BY: The Rox host the Loggers on today and Sunday before hitting the road once again. Tonight's game features a Rox baseball cap giveaway to the 1st 250 fans presented by Franklin Outdoor Advertising. Then Sunday is Father's Day at the Ballpark! LOGGERS PITCHER: JASON SEEVER (0-0, 7.44 ERA)

Seever is set to make his second start and fourth appearance this summer. So far, he has totaled 9.2 innings pitched and has 14 strikeouts to 4 walks. He has also allowed 9 hits and 8 runs. In his last appearance, the lefty struggled against Thunder Bay. In 3 innings he gave up 5 runs on 6 hits to the 18 batters he faced. He is originally Castro Valley, California and just ended his Junior year at the University of Arizona. He first attended Santa Clara in northern California in 2014 and 2015. He made 12 starts as a sophomore, and held a 6-3 record with 72.2 IP.
