#ROXREVIEW: St. Cloud got back on track after 18 tough innings against the MoonDogs. In that span they didn't score and only had 7 hits. Last night, they looked like their 1st half selves once again, winning a 5-4 ballgame in the bottom of the 9th. Drew Avans delivered the clutch single to drive in Michael Busch who led the inning off with a walk.

DON'T FORGET ABOUT ME: Keaton Kringlen has continued and continued to lead the Rox offense. After missing 3 games last week, Kringlen has been back in the lineup without skipping a beat. Last night, he had 3 RBI singles in his 1st three at-bats, giving him his 1st 3-hit game of the year. The BYU outfielder has also been one of the most consistent players in the lineup having at least 1 hit in the past 13 games, and in 19 of his last 20. After arriving in the 2nd week of June, Kringlen leads the Rox with a .350 average.

DON'T LET US GET AHEAD: Overall, the Rox rank 5th in the Northwoods League in hits and doubles. And when the hitters are clicking, it's bad news for the team in the opposite dugout. Following yesterday's W, they improved to 8-1 in games at home when they score 1st, and 20-5 on the entire season when they outhit opponents.

HOME SWEET HOME: The Rox started off their 4 game homestand before the All-Star break on a high note. They host the Stingers in a two game series starting tomorrow.
