



The St. Cloud Rox Baseball Club is seeking an enthusiastic individual for a Community Relations Internship for the summer of 2019. The Rox are a proud member of the finest developmental league for elite college baseball players, the Northwoods League. The Northwoods League has over 200 alumni who have gone on to play Major League Baseball. The Rox had nearly 55,000 fans attend games during the 2018 season. During their first seven seasons of existence, the club has been at or near the top of the Northwoods League's North Division in attendance while creating an environment that is entertaining for families of Central Minnesota.

RESPONSIBILITIES: (Reports directly to Director of Community Relations. This position starts in early/mid May and ends mid/late August)

- Coordinates community events with players, coaches and mascot
 - Works with local libraries, Boys & Girls Clubs, nursing homes and hospitals to set up player/mascot appearances
 - Works with the Director of Community Relations to schedule Rox coaches, players and mascot for community appearances
 - Works with local youth baseball leagues to set up clinics with the team (Confirms location and number of kids in each clinic with community education or youth baseball coordinator in respective towns)
 - Coordinates transportation of players and coaches to each community appearance (Takes pictures, hands out giveaways, etc. at appearances)
- Coordinates Rox appearances in local parades throughout the summer months
 - Researches local parade dates, entry fees, etc.
 - Leads a team of interns and mascot handing out pocket schedules as well as other information at parades.
- Help Coordinate Rox Kids Club – updating member roster, distributing shirts/tickets, organizing Kids Club events
- Other duties include but not limited to:
 - Ballpark Set Up
 - Set up and manage Fan Services table
 - Assists Rox staff to setup the ballpark for upcoming games
 - Assists in the setup of Suites, Merchandise stands, ticket booth, giveaway items, picnic areas, etc.
 - Wipes down seating bowl prior to gates opening
 - Work in ticket office to help answer phone calls, sell tickets, etc. as needed
 - Helps distribute 100,000 pocket schedules throughout Central Minnesota
- In-Game
 - Assist ticketing intern in the ticket booth selling tickets to walk up buyers and distributing Will Call tickets
 - Help Promotions Team with organizing and executing on-field promotions
- Post-Game
 - Helps distribute coupons to fans exiting the ballpark
 - Helps organize and store all stools, chairs, tables, merchandise, umbrellas, etc. on suites and deck for the next game
