

FOOD & BEVERAGE MANAGEMENT

The Food & Beverage Intern will take part in food preparation, catered events, concessions, and team meals. This summer internship program runs from mid-May to late August and focuses heavily on building culinary skills through daily menu creations, food preparation, and staff management. A background in the Food and Beverage industry or culinary arts is preferred. The Food & Beverage Intern must be available for every home game, along with any additional events assigned throughout the season.

Responsibilities Include:

- Fulfill daily food preparation requirements
- Assist in ordering and receiving inventory
- Prepare pre/post-game team meals for both home and away teams
- Knowledge of Catered Event Menu and Woodchucks outing areas
- Manage distribution of catered menu items
- Assist in the execution of daily food and beverage operations
- Assist in preparation of ballpark for daily events (catered events, concessions, team meals, etc.)
- Knowledge of all game-day activities and specialties
- Assist in presentation and cleanliness of ballpark before, during, and after game

Required Qualifications:

- Knowledge of Food Safety Requirements
- Food preparation skills
- Ability to create daily specials and execute them at game time
- Ability to delegate tasks to game-day staff
- Capable of taking direction to complete assigned tasks
- Ability to be decisive and problem solve in high pressure situations
- Ability to multi-task
- Must be self-motivated, organized, and have a great attention to detail
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to lift up to 75 lbs.
