The Video/Webcast Production Intern must be available for all home games, along with any additional events assigned throughout the season.

Responsibilities Include:

- Setup, operate and problem solve a 4-camera video broadcast of 36 home games
- Capture, edit and publish game highlights for NWL use
- Produce commercials for NWL webcast
- Conduct Player/Coach interviews
- Conduct and produce promotional segments
- Work closely with other video staff members to produce a multi-platform live webcast
- Cut show elements such as b-roll, highlights, batting practice clips and bullpen clips
- Team headshots
- Produce weekly articles on the team, to be posted on team's media sites
