The Marketing and Promotions Intern will report to the Director of Marketing & Corporate Service. The Marketing and Promotions Intern must be available for all home games, along with any additional events assigned throughout the season.

Responsibilities Include:

- Take the lead on implementing all pre-game, in-game and post-game promotions
- Help to write the game scripts
- Coordinate and book pre-game activities for the season i.e. National Anthem, Play Ball Kid, Tike on the Mike, etc.
- Attend player/mascot/organization appearances in the community
- Create new and fun on-field promotions and marketing ideas
- Select and coordinate promotional contests during the game
- Distribute giveaways at stadium entrances
- Help purchase props to coordinate with theme nights
- Organize promotional equipment, giveaways, and coupons prior to each game
- Assist with organizing and executing on-field promotions during games
- Help to edit, cut and update music for games and run the music during games
- Assist with fulfillment of sponsorship contracts
- Assist with stadium set-up and clean up
- Will be required to work office/stadium hours on non-game days which will include planning for upcoming promotional dates, scheduling pre-game activities, distributing pocket schedules, and answering phone calls as needed
- All other duties as assigned

- Requires ability to work flexible schedule including nights and weekends
- Comfortable interacting with all levels within organization as well as outside contacts
